

Deal Town Council spent 2015 working

Events - Listed below are some events that were organised by Deal Town Council during 2015/16. All were open to the public and free to attend:

Braderie: The September annual street Fayre was a great success, the weather was kind and the public turned up in their 1000s to grab a bargain and browse through the antiques and memorabilia.

Charter Day: The traditional church service was held at St Georges Church on 13 October to commemorate the date that the town of Deal received its "Charter of Incorporation" from King William III on 13 October 1699, this gave the town the standing of a 'Borough and Market Town'.

Town Hall Christmas Fayre: This popular annual event was held on 21 December at the Town Hall. Children were invited to join in making Christmas crafts to take home, face painting, tea and cakes all provided for free. There were also lots of stalls offering a variety of gifts and foods to purchase for last minute gifts. Father Christmas had his own Christmas grotto ready for him to meet the children and give out free Christmas presents, this is



definitely an annual event to mark in your calendar to get into the Christmas spirit!

Deal in Bloom Working Group: The Deal in Bloom Working group achieved another success winning a Silver Gilt Award in the South and South East in Bloom Competition in 2015. The group put a number of hours each into the planning and liaising with other organisations to help make Deal a pleasant place to live and work, with colourful containers/hanging baskets along the High Street, along the Sea Front on the lamp columns, the Scented Garden on the High Street, also working with Dover District Council for the colour scheme.

We held our own 'Bloom' Competition for Deal Town Residents, with worthy winners of Cups and Certificates being presented in the Town Hall by the Mayor at a special event. We are fortunate to have home-owners who are proud to make their front gardens a pleasing sight for others to enjoy, and I thank them on behalf of Deal Town Council and the working group. I also thank our businesses along the Sea Front who go the extra mile with their extremely colourful displays of flowers on their properties, and also on the entertainment area.

This coming year 2016 will be no exception in our endeavours to make Deal the most colourful coastal town along the South Coast, Deal is entered into the South and South East in Bloom Awards and the prestigious Britain in Bloom so 'watch this space'! Finance & General Purposes Committee: The 2015/16 Finance and General Purpose Committee has had a busy and successful year in ensuring expenditure has been undertaken wisely during the year whilst at the same time ensuring services have not been cut

The year has seen initiatives taken by the Town Hall staff to generate extra revenue from the active promotion to the Town Hall for events and through promotion of additional products by the Tourist Information centre

In addition savings were made with new contracts for the photo copier, p.o.s card machine, utilities, the revision of the previously planned 4 year program to replace the robes for the Town Council and the decision by all the Conservative Town Councillors, one Labour Town Councillor and the Mayor to not take their allowances this year. As a result the Town Council in 2016-17 has been able to reduce Deal ratepayers contribution to the precept by 2% whilst still maintaining services and to increase reserves.

Planning committee: Deal Town Council's planning committee faced a bit of a challenge for the 2015-2016 year because 5 of the 7 members of the committee had never sat on a planning committee before. Only Cllr Bond and I have served on Town & District planning committees.

But we also have Robin Green from the Deal Society & Bill Elliott from the Friends of North Deal who sit on the planning committee as advisory members without voting rights and these two gentlemen are a great asset to our committee.

We faced some very controversial planning applications over the year like the South Street proposals and this planning committee listened to the public and between us we got KCC to agree with Deal Town Council and change their plans.

And we have Mrs Kelly Lawrence the Planning Clerk & Mrs Lorna Crow the Town Clerk to thank for all the hard work that they put in for our meetings.

I would also like to take this opportunity to thank all members of our planning committee because they have done very well and I hope you will all continue to serve on this committee next year, I know it is not an easy committee to serve on because you can't please everyone and yes we have rules to keep to. Thank you all.
